

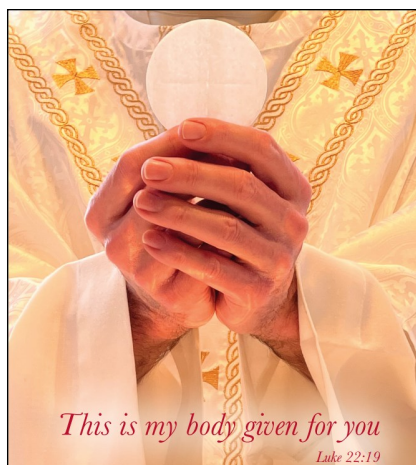
## Dear Families:

August is here, and we are excitedly planning our 2022-2023 Faith Formation year at Christ the King! **Classes will begin on Sunday, October 16<sup>th</sup> through Tuesday, October 18<sup>th</sup>.** Most sessions will return to meeting in person, and keeping everyone safe and healthy continues to be our primary concern.

## Here's what you need to know:

- **The deadline for submitting your completed registration forms and payment to our Faith Formation office is Monday, October 3<sup>rd</sup>.** Please send these items either by mail to the address above, by scanning and e-mailing your forms to [ljensen@ctkparishny.org](mailto:ljensen@ctkparishny.org), or by placing them inside our wooden Faith Formation drop box (located on the right side of our Parish Center entrance). We will process registration forms in the order in which they are received. **After registering, you will receive your child(ren)'s class calendar by e-mail.**
- **Tuition is \$60 per child, \$100 for two children, and a maximum of \$125 per family and is due along with your registration form.** This charge helps cover the cost of our curriculum materials, mailings, classroom supplies, retreats, special events, and more. (There is no additional fee for a sacramental year.) Please make checks payable to *Christ the King* with "Faith Formation registration" written on the memo line. *Do not delay your registration due to financial concerns! Payment arrangements are available and always remain confidential.*
- For young people entering Grade 2 (First Reconciliation/First Communion) and Grade 11 (Confirmation), **please include a copy of their baptismal certificate. We also need a baptismal certificate for any children who are new to Faith Formation at Christ the King.**
- **Wearing masks during Faith Formation classes and events is now optional.** Extra masks will be available in case any student would like one. Our classrooms and materials will be sanitized regularly for safety.

This year's theme for Catechetical Sunday comes from the Gospel of Luke: **"This is my body given for you"** (22:19). Our Church is also currently celebrating a **National Eucharistic Revival**, which kicked off during Corpus Christi weekend 2022. The *Catechism of the Catholic Church* tells us that the Eucharist is the "source and summit" of Christian life.
